"Marcus and I weren't exactly on good terms recently.

That doesn't mean I killed him.

I spent the evening around the ski facilities getting equipment organised.

People saw me moving around because that's part of my job.

I never entered the workshop and I never attacked Marcus."

Further questioning revealed Jake became reluctant to discuss certain recent interactions with management.

Statement of Eleanor Shaw

"Marcus and I discussed investor materials earlier in the evening.

Nothing unusual.

After that I spent the evening attending the reception and speaking with guests.

I only became aware something was wrong when security gathered everyone together after the body was discovered."

Statement of Noah Bennett

Security Supervisor

"I was conducting a routine patrol at approximately 10:20 PM.

As I approached the maintenance workshop I noticed the door was not fully closed.

That was unusual.

When I looked inside I discovered Marcus Vale lying on the floor.

I immediately called for assistance."

Statement of Emma Clarke

Reception Manager

"I saw Marcus heading toward the maintenance corridor beneath the gondola station shortly after ten o'clock.

He appeared distracted and in a hurry.

Several minutes later I noticed another person heading in the same general direction.

I didn't think anything of it at the time."

MEDICAL EXAMINATION REPORT

Office of the County Coroner

Victim: Marcus Vale

Estimated Time of Death

Between approximately 10:12 PM and 10:20 PM.

Findings

- Major impact wound to the rear left side of the skull.
- Fracture of the occipital bone.
- Extensive internal bleeding.
- Bruising to both forearms.
- Minor abrasions to the hands.
- No evidence of poisoning.

Cause of Death

Fatal blunt force trauma to the head.

Additional Observations

The injuries suggest a brief physical confrontation may have occurred before the fatal injury was sustained.
